



AUTUMN RIDERS POKER RIDE

Some thoughts that we have come up with as guidelines for a successful poker ride ... September 29, 2019 – Rain date is October 27, 2019

50/50 Raffle when you sign up; *50% of the take on the raffle goes to the winner drawn.*

We'll have "**guess the mileage for a buck**" game where we'll have a graph full of mileage numbers and for a buck you'll be able to buy a square. Then the person who bought the square closest to the actual mileage wins \$20.

Food and (soft) drinks afterwards... last chance to purchase additional raffle tickets, **50/50 Raffle** chances before the drawing.

At the beginning or the end, have a chance to **buy an extra card** to try and improve your hand.

The Route... Before leaving.. When you register (and sign a ride release) you'll be drawing a **playing card**. You'll receive a playing form – where our point sitters will have you fill in the card you receive at each point. So on the top of the form is name, address, ect. And on the bottom of the form are 6 blank playing cards. So when you register, you'll reach into the bag and pull out a card... the person there writes in one of the blank cards what it is and initials it.

Registration starts at 8:30Am, Riders out between 9 -11:00Am (for example) and if you come in with groups, you'll be able to leave with your group. Everyone can follow the directions and do the route at their own speed.

THIS IS NOT A TIMED EVENT...1:15 PM food and prizes will Open... So if you decide to stop for sightseeing or whatever, you'll know when to be back.

On the directions we'll have emergency **telephone numbers**. **There will be three stops along the route.** The stops (close to) evenly placed.



At each stop you'll **draw another card** and the point sitters write down the number. So you'll be picking playing **cards** at each stop. At the end of the ride, you'll draw **your final card** (and buy a extra one) if you want...

The last stop all the cards of the deck will be on a board and you were given a dart to shoot at the board to get your last card.

The prizes awarded for at the end of the ride? We've used our imagination. Best hand, 2nd place, third place, oldest rider, and youngest rider, worst poker hand.

Spread the word; get a group of friends together, we accept Checks, Cash and Venom.
